











Hot spring footbath "Ahirunoyu"

**Babbling stream walking course**  
 1.5 km  
 This route goes around the Achi River which flows through the centre of Hirugami Hot Spring area. An easy course with cherry trees blossoming in spring and ginkgo trees changing colour in autumn. Taking a relaxing hot spring footbath along the way is our humble suggestion.

**Satoyama walking course**  
 A sunlit tree road 1.2 km course on a narrow pathway. Midway along this woodland trail there is a statue of Buddha where you can stop for a moment's reflection.
